The Southern California Kendo Championships will be held 6/24/01 at Wilson Park in Torrance. Attached is the SCKC roster for your dojo. It was generated from the database for this tournament.

Note: please ignore the height/weight column (unless it is highlighted), as this information hasn't been entered into the database yet. The SCKF Tournament Committee has proposed some new tournament policies which have been discussed, amended, and approved by the Board. These include the following:

- Sign-in for all divisions, including yudansha, will be closed at 8:45am.
- Yudansha, adult kyu, and youth kyu 14 years and older are expected to help with court duty

The roster indicates the preliminary court duty assignments for each participant. The following is a summary of tournament duties:

- Toban (setup, refreshments, donations table, clean up)  
**Covina, Norwalk, Pasadena, San Fernando Valley, Tustin**
- Sign in desk and roll call for 0-6 kyu, 5-4 kyu  
**Yudansha** (individuals to be named this week)
- Court duties (announcer, scoreboard, timekeepers, tasuki, coordinators)
  - Senior/Women's/Kyu divisions:  
**yudansha**
  - Adult division:  
**kyu 14 and older** and 2 parents each from **Covina, Norwalk, OCB, Torrance**
  - Yudansha (individual championship)  
**adult kyu**
  - Team  
**adult kyu and kyu 14 and older**

Note that the court duty assignments will be under review in the next week and may be modified slightly. If you know of any of your kenshi who are not capable of doing even the simplest court duty, please inform Jean Kodama asap.
