**** Players**

I am requesting that each Player (Senshu) bring one set of MEJIRUSHI (Tasuki) 1-Red and 1-White to the 2008 All United States Kendo Championships. Mejrushi **WILL NOT** be prepared or provided by the AUSKF.

*** Shinpan**

I am requesting that each selected Shinpan to please bring one set of SHINPAN-KI 1-Red and 1-White to the 2008 All United States Kendo Championship venues; including the Shinpan Seminar.

**** MEJIRUSHI (Tasuki):**

International Kendo Federation The Regulations of Kendo Shiai and Shinpan:

Article 4 : Shiai-sha (Player) shall wear at the crossing point of Do strings Mejrushi, a strip of cloth, either red or white, in the total length of 70 centimeters and width of 5 centimeters.

*** The uniform of Shinpan:**

IKF The Regulations of Kendo Shiai and Shinpan:

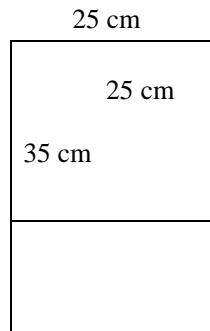
Article 23 : The uniform of Shinpan-in shall be as follows, unless otherwise stipulated in each tournament:

1.A plain, dark blue jacket ; 2.A plain, gray pair of trousers ; 3.A plain, white shirt ; 4.A plain, deep red necktie ; and 5.A plain, dark blue pair of socks.

*** Shinpan-ki:**

IKF The Regulations of Kendo Shiai and Shinpan:

Article 6: The specification of Shinpan-ki are show in Figure; the standard for the flag handles shall be 1.5 centimeters in diameter.
