- 1. THE TIME LIMITS FOR ENCHO WILL BE CHANGING THERE WILL ONLY BE ONE (1) ENCHO OF “2 MIN” FOR INDIVIDUAL JUNIOR/NON-DEGREE/LADIES/1-2 DAN DIVISIONS AS WELL AS ONLY ONE (1) “3 MIN” ENCHO FOR THE 3 DAN/4 DAN & ABOVE DIVISIONS.**
2. Categories are subject to change depending upon the number of entries
3. Participants will be allowed to enter into **one (1) Individual category only.**
4. Due to the high number of entrants and the use of four (4) courts, it will be the responsibility of each Kenshi/Delegation Leader to ensure that their players are available at their properly designated courts or risk disqualification.
