- Left into temple parking lot

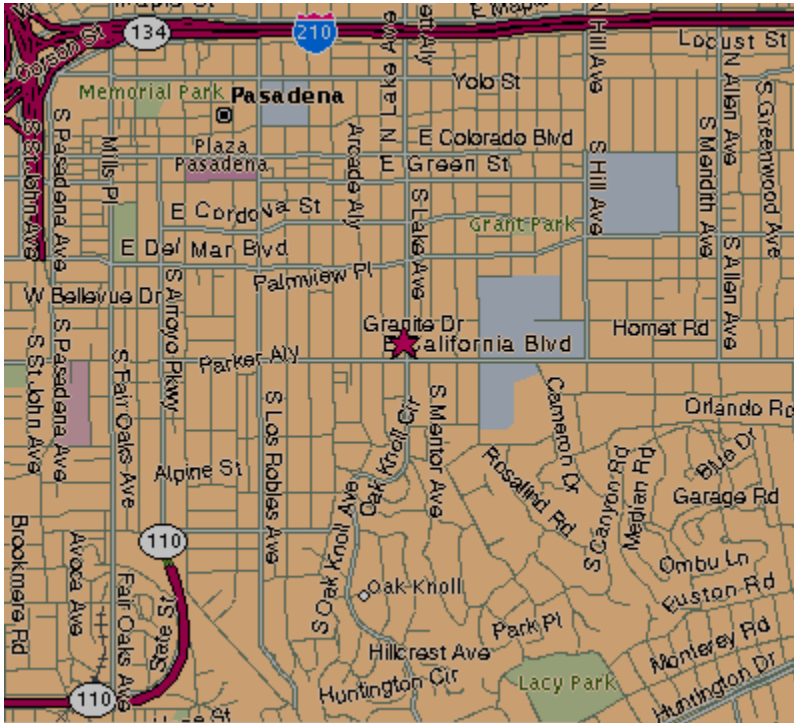
