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INFORMATION

1. A PRIMARY CONTACT PERSON over 18 years old should be assigned for each team and his or her phone number or e-mail address must be listed on the application form.
2. Regulations of the matches will follow “The Regulation of Kendo Shiai and Shinpan” set forth by the Federation of International Kendo (FIK).
3. Tsuki waza is authorized for YUDANSHA DIVISION only.
4. Each person can only participate in one division and is responsible for bringing one’s own Me-Jirushi (Red/White indicator)
5. **Each dojo must provide one or more shinpan for every 10 participants. However we always have not enough number of shinpan, so please provide as many as possible.**
