Please check only those persons confirmed to attend.

For each participant, enter the appropriate fee amount in the "\$" column. Fees are \$6 for all kyu, including adults, and \$11 for yudansha. Fees are non-refundable.

If you wish to add a new member as a non-championship team participant, fill in all of the information on the roster (name, rank, etc.). In addition, submit a dues form, preferably with separate SCKF and AUSKF checks. See the SCKF website (http://www.eanet.com/sckf) for dues amounts and forms. If you wish to "borrow" a person from another dojo for one of your non-championship teams (see bottom of page), that person must also be a paid member of SCKF. The application form (both roster and team order) is due September 13, 2003. Please turn it in to Tomoji Kato at or prior to the September Board meeting. It is recommended that you make a copy for your records. No forms will be accepted without payment in full, payable to SCKF.

The non-championship team orders will be fixed throughout the tournament, i.e. the names and order cannot be changed on tournament day. All draws will be random, so if a dojo submits two teams there is a possiblity of playing each other first round. A dojo which cannot field a non-championship team in a given category may submit one team by "borrowing" one person each from one or two other dojos.

The championship team order for the first match will be due the day of the tournament, after match ups have been drawn. The players must come from the submitted list, i.e. no new names on tournament day.
