- No forms will be accepted without dojo head instructor's signature (see below).
- Please make sure all applicants and volunteers are confirmed to attend.
- For those requesting 1 kyu and above, a completed written test must be submitted when signing in at the shinsa, and kenshi must be prepared to perform kata test at the shinsa.
