### How does score keeping works...

- 1) The placement will be determined by the most wins in the group.
- 2) If wins totals are tied, least amount of losses will determine the group placement.
- 3) If both wins and losses are tied, the most amount of ties will determine the group placement.
- 4) If the wins, losses, and ties are all tied, the most points scored will determine the group placement
- 5) If everything above ends up as a tie, the least amount of points allowed will determine the group placement

1st Place	TEAM
2nd Place	AA-1
3rd Place	ELIMINATED

### Rules and Regulations

- 1) Time limit for each match will be 4 minutes, 2 minutes encho, hikiwake
- 2) In case of players with exact same score, there will be an ippon shobu to determine the seeding for the next round.
- 3) Joudan, Nito, Tsuki will be valid in Men, Women's Senior and Senior Youth Boys
- 4) Joudan, Nito, Tsuki WILL NOT be valid in Junior Youth Boys, Junior Youth Girls, and Mudansha
